Manuscript preparation : Manuscript should be typeset in double space on A4 size paper as : Title, Authors' name, address, phone, fax etc., Abstract, Key words, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Result, Discussion, Acknowledgement and References. The result and discussion may, however, be combined if needed for better expression. References should be arranged alphabetically and set out as follows:

The names of the journals must be abbreviated according to the 'World List of Scientific Periodicals'.

References need be strictly in the format and style of the Journal.

Publication Ethics :

Plagiarism : The authors are required to submit plagiarism report as per International requirements. Manuscripts that are found to have been plagiarized from a manuscript by other authors, whether published or unpublished, will incur plagiarism sanctions.

Data Fabrication and Falsification : Submitted manuscripts that are found to have either fabricated or falsified experimental results, including the manipulation of images, will incur data fabrication and falsification sanctions.

Scrutiny of the manuscript : All the papers submitted for publication in *J. Exp. Zool. India* will be reviewed by atleast two referees and their decision shall be final. However, Chief Editor retains the right to accept or reject the article. The final decision regarding the manuscript shall be communicated to the corresponding author within two months from the date of receipt of the manuscript.

Reprints and Publication Charges : There is no publication charges. However, authors have to bear the cost of minimum 25 reprints.
